Year 7 Catch Up Premium Plan 2019/20

The Catch Up Premium

The Academy receives additional funding known as the “Year 7 catch up premium” that is provided to support any pupil who did not reach a score of 100 in their year 6 SATs (low prior attainers). The amount of this funding for the 2019-20 academic year is estimated to be £15889. In total 42 students failed to meet the expected standard in Reading whilst 45 students failed to meet the expected standard in Maths. Below is a table detailing a range of the school’s provisions which have been allocated to disadvantaged students - those pupils in year 7 eligible for catch up funding.
